The [Spring Fashions event](#), which will present village retailers' spring and summer clothing lines, starts at 10 a.m. Sunday, March 24.

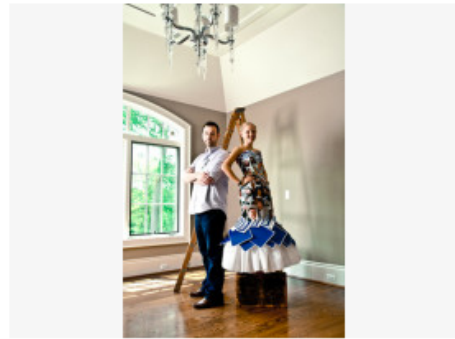
It will be held in a heated tent at the village, located at the Northeast Corner of Adams and Walton Boulevard.
